1963 Singer Vogue II: This vehicle has a 4 door saloon (sedan) body style with a front positioned engine driving through the rear wheels. The 4 cylinder, overhead valve naturally aspirated engine has 2 valves per cylinder and a displacement of 1.6 litres. 1963 Singer Vogue Estate Car: The Vogue Estate Car is a rear wheel drive estate/station wagon passenger car with a front placed engine, from Singer. The Singer Vogue Estate Car's engine is a naturally aspirated petrol, 1.6 litre, overhead valve 4 cylinder with 2 valves per cylinder. It produces 58 bhp (59 PS/43 kW) of power at 4400 rpm, and maximum torque of 117 N·m (86 lb·ft/11.9 kgm) at ...Singer Vogue 1963. This appears to be one of the first Series II cars in the UK with a suffix letter ("A") on its registration plate. The first generation Singer Vogue I/II/III/IV models of 1961 to 1966, was a badge engineered version of the Hillman Super Minx.
